OUR MISSION

Texas Gun Sense (TGS) works to prevent gun violence and other gun tragedies in Texas through education, partnerships, and policy change.

How we achieve this mission:

- We educate the public, lawmakers, and the media about solutions to prevent gun deaths and injuries.
- We collaborate with partners to advance gun safety initiatives at the state, local, and community levels.
- We advocate for common sense, evidence-based policies that reduce gun violence while respecting the rights of responsible gun owners.

2023 Legislative Wins


During the 88th legislative session, we successfully advanced a measure requiring school districts to educate parents about **safe gun storage** to keep our homes and schools safer.

TGS also helped Uvalde families push for a bipartisan committee vote on the **Raise the Age** bill - a historic victory for survivors and advocates.

Every session, we help to fund and grow the <u>Keep 'Em Safe,</u> <u>Texas</u> campaign to educate the community about safe gun storage.



We also **defeated harmful bills** that would weaken accountability for carrying guns in prohibited places, allow short-barreled rifles, and let school marshals openly carry firearms.

Advocacy

In February, we brought **600** advocates and **30** partner organizations together for the 2023 Texas Majority to End Gun Violence Advocacy Day. We heard from survivors, gun owners, veterans, and students. Volunteers visited every lawmaker in the Capitol.



We continued the momentum by training legislative advocates and releasing our new **Advocacy Toolkit**.



Youth Advocacy

We've ramped up our work with youth advocates to empower a generation that has grown up with the trauma of active shooter drills and school shootings. We'll continue to share our **Youth Toolkit** and offer ongoing opportunities for students.




Partnerships

TGS leads the **Texas Coalition to Prevent Gun Violence --**

organizations and experts working in gun safety as intersectional advocates for issues including mental health and domestic abuse.

New partners include Texas Doctors for Social Responsibility, National Council of Jewish Women Austin, and Texas Impact. TGS co-leads the **Texas Invest In Us Coalition** in partnership with Community Justice Action Fund, a Black and Brown-led organization dedicated to ending gun violence in the most impacted communities.





With partners across the country, we are crafting our **89th legislative session** strategy to have maximum impact.



Media & Communications

During the 2023 legislative session, TGS appeared in more than **50** news pieces and led multiple press events, shaping the narrative alongside survivors and partners.

We continue to provide critical information on the state's gun violence crisis and the solutions we need to save lives. Our **new website** serves as a launchpad for advocates. We are educating Texans through events and our social media channels, which gained more than **2,000** new followers this year.



Reducing Gun Deaths



Community Violence Intervention

Youth, domestic violence victims, and Black and Hispanic men are at highest risk of gun violence.

One of our top priorities is advocating for Community Violence Intervention Programs that reduce gun violence for communities at highest risk.

Suicide Prevention

TGS is supporting **gun safety research** to prevent firearm suicide and other tragedies. We are working with a coalition of doctors, gun dealers, and veterans to expand temporary gun storage for Texans.

Our November event, **A Safer Texas**, inspired attendees with speeches from Representative Vikki Goodwin, a student advocate, and a trauma surgeon.


We will always support survivors as they honor their loved ones with action. Join us in 2024 as we continue to build A Safer Texas!
